June 22:

Isaac went into some detail about tweaking control surfaces to experiment with how the glider behaves and we encouraged them to take home the glider and experiment with different settings.

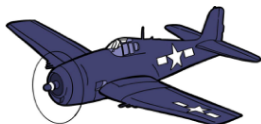
